How do your staff and services promote recovery?

The measures used by Reaching Recovery partners enables centers to provide services based on real time recovery-focused outcomes.

Reaching Recovery Instruments:

- RNL: Assigns correct level of service
- CRM: Consumers rating of recovery
- RMI: Providers rating of recovery
- PRO: Consumers rating of provider

These four instruments provide multidimensional views of recovery. This knowledge empowers staff and consumers at all levels of your center to promote and support recovery.
