Stretch your dollars to serve more people

As people recover from mental illness their needs change over time. The four measurement instruments used by Reaching Recovery members help community behavioral healthcare centers track consumers progress and enable centers to graduate people to less intensive services when appropriate.

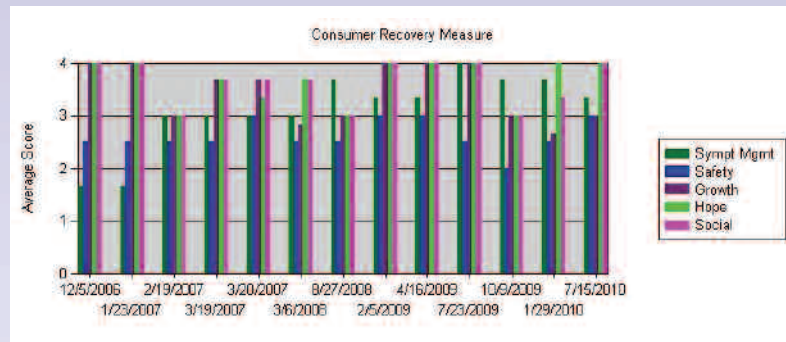
Using these instruments, the Mental Health Center of Denver was able to increase capacity by 25 percent as more consumers graduated to less intensive levels of services. This met a tremendous need in the community without added cost.

The Reaching Recovery instruments measure how recovery is taking hold throughout a mental health center by building on strengths and empowering individuals.

Are the people you're serving moving to wellness?

Know how people recover and have the ability to measure it. The instruments used by Reaching Recovery members display real-time data to help appropriate service delivery and support clinical decisions.

How do your staff and services promote recovery?

The measures used by Reaching Recovery partners enables centers to provide services based on real time recovery-focused outcomes.

Reaching Recovery Instruments:

Recovery Needs Level: Assigns correct level of service

Consumer Recovery Measure: Consumer's rating of their own recovery

Recovery Marker Inventory: Provider's rating of recovery

Promoting Recovery in Organizations: Consumer's rating of provider

These four instruments provide multidimensional views of recovery. This knowledge empowers staff and consumers at all levels of your center to promote and support recovery.
